The Management of **BREAD FREE** views the Quality Management System as a means to manage our processes and products, identified risks, legal requirements, and the continuous improvement of the System's effectiveness. To this end, the **BREAD FREE** Management Quality System is based on:

- Compliance with applicable legislation and regulations, as well as with other requirements agreed with our customers and subscribed to by BREAD FREE.
- Ensuring the quality and safety of products.
- Promoting a **Food Safety Culture**, starting from the highest level of our organizational structure and cascading throughout the organization.
- Establishing and regularly reviewing objectives and targets consistent with the commitments assumed in this statement. The effective application of these principles requires the support of both management and employees.
- Maintaining facilities in a hygienic condition that is safe for food, in accordance with applicable regulations.
- Training and raising awareness among organizational personnel to ensure the proper development of all activities carried out, especially in food handling, applying **Good Practices related to Food Safety**.
- Promoting internal and external communication as a guiding pillar of our Management System.

The commitment, collaboration, and motivation of all personnel at **BREAD FREE** are essential requirements. To achieve these goals, **BREAD FREE** will maintain a systematic approach for identifying training needs and planning training activities, and will provide all personnel with the necessary resources, all aimed at ensuring compliance with this Policy.

This Policy shall be reviewed periodically in order to develop the concept of **continuous improvement** as a key element to achieve excellence and maintain leadership in the market.
